



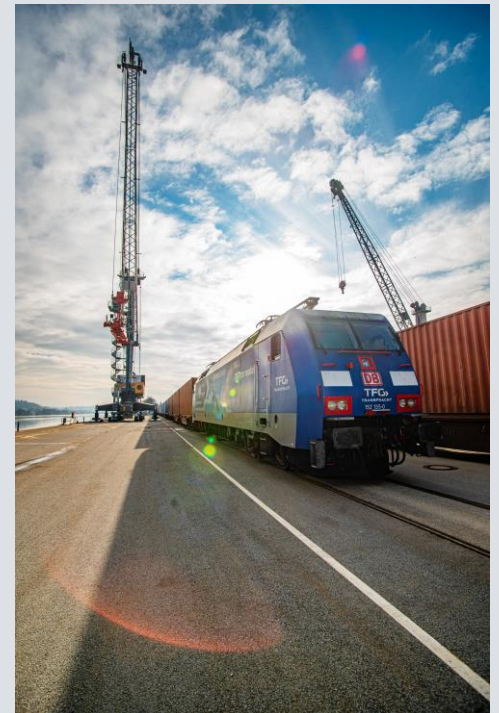
» Non-stop from Passau to the North Sea – in combined or single wagonload transport

Every day, TFG Transfracht's AlbatrosExpress provides high-frequency connections between Passau and the major northern German seaports: Hamburg, Bremerhaven and Wilhelmshaven. The hub and transshipment point is the bayernhafen Passau terminal. The integrated solution means TFG can offer both combined and single-wagonload transport.
